Casual Shabbat service filled with the tunes of the Beach Boys and more – enjoy surfin' and the cool breezes of summer.

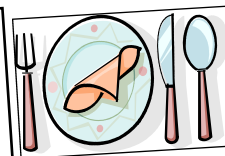

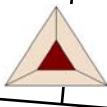
